2.Accordingly, this writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn. No costs.

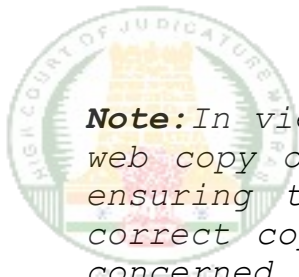
