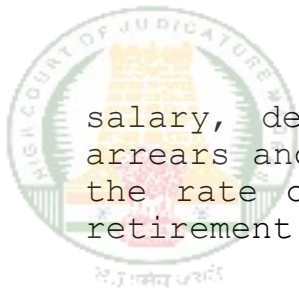

Prayer in WP(MD) . 23780/ 2016 :

Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying for the issuance of a Writ of Mandamus by directing the respondents to settle the retirement benefits payable to the petitioner including service gratuity, commutation amount, leave



salary, dearness allowance arrears, pension, revised pension with arrears and all other attendant retirement benefits with interest at the rate of not less than 18% per annum payable from the date of retirement viz. 31.05.2014.
