3. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent would submit that the petitioner has been complying with the conditions.

4. Considering the said submissions and nature of offence, the condition imposed by this Court in Crl.O.P(MD).No.17123 of 2022, is



modified to the effect that the petitioner shall report before respondent police once in a month i.e., on first working day of every month at 10:30 a.m., until further orders.
