Prayer in Crl.A.(MD)No.712 of 2022:-

This Criminal Appeal has been filed under Section 14(A)(2) SC/ST (POA) Act, to call for the records pertaining to order passed by the Sessions Judge Special Court for exclusive trial of cases under SC/ST (POA) Act, 1989, Sivagangai in Crl.M.P.No.1438 of 2022 dated 31.10.2022 and set aside the same and release the appellant/petitioner on bail in Cr.No.36 of 2022 on the file of the second respondent.
