2. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) appearing for the respondents 1 and 2.

The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner has preferred a complaint alleging that the respondents 3 and 4 have forcefully entered into the house of the petitioner and abused him in filthy language and also attacked him and that the petitioner's wife has sustained injuries.

5. In view of the above, the second respondent police is directed to follow the dictum laid down in the case of ***Lalita Kumari Vs. Government of Uttar Pradesh and Others*** reported in ***(2014) 2 SCC 1*** and pass orders in accordance with law.

6. With the above direction, this Criminal Original Petition stands disposed of.
