ORDER:

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr.P.C.') by the petitioner-Accused seeking to quash the proceedings against him in SC No.257 of 2017 on the file of VIII Additional District and Sessions Judge at Miryalaguda, Nalgonda District, which arose out of Crime No.278 of 2016 of Miryalaguda Town Police Station, Nalgonda District.

2. On instructions and as per the e-courts case status proceedings, learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that the subject Sessions Case was ended in acquittal on 02.11.2021. Hence, the prayer sought for in the present petition has become infructuous.
