ORDER:-

This petition is filed under Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 to quash the interim order dated 09.03.2016 in CrI.M.P.No.8 of 2016 in M.C.No.27 of 2016 passed by the Judge, Family Court-cum-VIII Addl. Sessions Judge's Court at Mahabubnagar.

2. Heard Dr. Challa Srinivas Reddy, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. Ganesh, learned Assistant Public Prosecutor for the respondent No.2 – State and perused the material on record.

3. It is seen from the record that the court below has passed orders dated 09.03.2016 in CrI.M.P.No.8 of 2016 in M.C.No.27 of 2015, wherein, an amount of Rs.4,000/- was granted as interim maintenance to respondent No.1 herein payable by the petitioner herein.

4. The letter dated 24.06.2022 received from the Judge, Family Court-cum-III Addl. District and Sessions Judge, Mahabubnagar goes to show that the main case M.C.No.27 of 2016 has already been disposed of on 21.11.2017.

5. Under the circumstances, the learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that no cause of action survives and the petition has become infructuous.

6. Considering the submission of learned counsel for the petitioner, this petition is dismissed as infructuous.

Consequently, miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed.
