This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. seeking pre-arrest bail to the petitioner/Accused No.4, in the event of his arrest in connection with Crime No.1175 of 2021 on the file of Jeedimerla Police Station, Cyberabad, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 420, 409 of Indian Penal Code.

2. Heard the learned Counsel for the petitioner and learned Assistant Public Prosecutor for the respondent-State.

3. Though this Court directed the petitioner to pay the outstanding amount of Rs.14,85,000/- and extended the time for paying the said amount, thrice, the petitioner failed to make the payment.

Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is dismissed.
