ORDER:

This Criminal Petition is filed challenging the orders dated 28.03.2016 in CrI.M.P.No.948 of 2016 in Crime No.33 of 2016 of Women Police Station, CCS, DD, Hyderabad, on the file of XIII Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Nampally, Hyderabad, wherein the petition to conduct potency test to the respondent No.1 therein was allowed.

No representation on behalf of the petitioner, even after posting this matter today under the caption "for dismissal" in the cause list, the very fact that the petitioner has not been attending this Court to prosecute his case shows that the purpose for which this petition is filed may not survive and thereby this matter might have become infructuous.
