CRIMINAL PETITION No.2067 of 2018

ORDER:

This criminal petition is filed under Section 482 read with Section 440(2) of Cr.P.C. seeking reduction of the surety amount from Rs.1,25,000/- with one surety to Rs.1,25,000/- with one personal bond. The above said conditions were imposed in Cr.I.M.P.No.2756 of 2017 in Crime No.247 of 2017, by the learned Metropolitan Sessions Judge, Hyderabad.

2. Heard the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor for respondent No.1. There is no representation for the petitioner.

3. Learned Assistant Public Prosecutor represented that the Police have completed the investigation and charge sheet has already been filed and it is numbered as S.C.No.970 of 2021.

4. Conditions in respect of surety imposed by the Court below is for securing the presence of accused during the course of investigation and during the course of trial. As the

Police have completed the investigation and filed charge sheet, the very purpose of filing this criminal petition has become infructuous. Added to it, none appeared for the petitioner. Considering the same, petition is liable to be dismissed.

5. In the result, the Criminal Petition is dismissed as infructuous. There shall be no order as to costs.

6. As a sequel, miscellaneous applications pending, if any, in this Criminal Petition, shall stand closed.
