ORDER:

This Criminal Petition is filed seeking quashment of proceedings in FIR No.280 of 2020 on the file of Police Station Alwal, registered against the accused for the offences under Section 363 of the Indian Penal Code.

02. No representation on behalf of the petitioner. Sri S.Ganesh, learned Assistant Public Prosecutor for respondents No.1 and 2/State is present.

03. Sri S.Ganesh, learned Assistant Public Prosecutor for the respondents No.1 and 2/State filed a letter dated 06.12.2022 addressed by the Sub-Inspector of Police, Alwal Police Station, Cyderabad Commissionerate, wherein it is stated that the police concerned have completed the investigation and charge sheet was filed and numbered as S.C.No.186 of 2022.
