Petition Under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order or direction more particularly in the nature of Writ of Quo Warranto, Declaring the action of the Respondent No.1 in issuing the GOrt. No. 8, Dt. 12-02-2021, extending the Deputation period (Second year) with effect from 28-12-2020, to 27-12-2021, of the Respondent No.6 based on the Appointment orders Vide GOrt No. 202, Dt. 28-12-2019, as Director Secretary, Telangana State Urdu Academy, Hyderabad, which is Contrary to the Rules 5(a) and(b) in Annexure II of Rules of the Telangana State Urdu Academy, Hyderabad, as illegal and void, and quash the same as Unconstitutional, illegal,

arbitrary and consequently restraining the 6th respondent from functioning as Director Secretary, Telangana State Urdu Academy, Hyderabad.

Petition Under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents No.1 and 2 not to extend the further deputation period (3rd year) of the 6th respondent as Director Secretary Telangana Sate Urdu Academy Hyderabad pending disposal of the above writ petition.
