No. APA/ALP/W28/ 2020/2763, dated 8-01-2020, declaring that the 2nd petitioner is unfit for employment, on the ground that he is suffering with Kidney and Agenesis, as illegal, arbitrary, contrary to the final orders made in W.P. No. 1178 of 2019, dated 10.6.2019, and consequently set aside the same, by holding that the 2nd petitioner is eligible and entitled for dependant employment in the 1st Respondent-Company, in view of the final orders of this Honourable Court in W.P.
