This Petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition and upon hearing the arguments of Sri M A K MUKHEED ,Advocate for the Petitioner and the Public Prosecutor on behalf of the Respondent No. R1 and Sri, P. Ravindra Reddy, Advocate for the Respondent No. R2.

The Court made the following: ORDER

CRIMINAL PETITION No.3199 OF 2020

ORDER:

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure by the petitioners-accused Nos.1 to 4 to quash the proceedings initiated against them in Crime No.78 of 2020 of Miryalaguda I Town Police Station, Nalgonda District, registered for the offences under Sections 326, 323, 504 of the Indian Penal Code.

2. There is no representation on behalf of the petitioners.

3. Learned counsel for respondent No.2-*de facto* complainant is present.

4. Learned Assistant Public Prosecutor appearing for respondent No.1-State has submitted that during pendency of this criminal petition, the Police concerned have completed the investigation and filed charge-sheet and the same was taken on file by the learned Judicial First Class Magistrate, Miryalaguda, and numbered as C.C.No.490 of 2022. Learned Assistant Public Prosecutor has filed a copy of letter dated 30.08.2022 addressed by

the Sub-Inspector of Police, Miryalaguda I Town Police Station, Nalgonda District, to the Public Prosecutor of the High Court to substantiate the same.

5. In view of the above submission, since entire investigation is completed and charge sheet is also filed, the very purpose of filing the criminal petition to quash Crime No.78 of 2020 of Miryalaguda I Town Police Station, Nalgonda District, is defeated and thereby the Criminal Petition has become infructuous and liable to be dismissed.

6. Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is dismissed as infructuous. However, the petitioners are given liberty to challenge the charge sheet, if they so desire.

Pending Miscellaneous Applications, if any, shall stand closed.
