JUDGMENT: *(Per the Hon'ble the Chief Justice Satish Chandra Sharma)*

The present writ appeal is arising out of an order dated 08.02.2022 passed by the learned Single Judge in W.P.No.6522 of 2022.

The order passed by the learned Single Judge reads as under:-

"When the matter is taken up for hearing, learned counsel on either side fairly conceded that the issue involved in this writ petition is squarely covered by the order dated 07.02.2022 passed by this Court in W.P.No.6493 of 2022.

Following the order dated 07.02.2022 in W.P.No.6493 of 2022, this Writ Petition is dismissed. No costs.

Pending miscellaneous petitions, if any, shall stand closed."

The aforesaid order makes it very clear that it was an order passed on the concession made by the learned counsel for the appellant/writ petitioner and he agreed for dismissal of the writ petition.

Today, before this Court, learned counsel for the appellant/writ petitioner prays for withdrawal of the writ appeal with a liberty to file a review application against the aforesaid order.

The writ appeal is accordingly dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.

The miscellaneous applications pending, if any, shall stand closed. There shall be no order as to costs.
