Petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to quash the proceedings in Cr.No. 166 of 2019 on the file of the PS Alwal against the petitioners/Accused No.1 and 2 for the offences under section 420 and 506 of Indian Penal Code.

Petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay all further proceedings in pursuance of Crime No. 166 of 2019 on the file of the PS Alwal pending disposal of the main Criminal Petition and pass such other order or orders as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the circumstances of the case.

This Petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition and upon hearing the arguments of Sri THUMU CHANDRASHEKAR, Advocate for the Petitioners and of the Asst. Public Prosecutor on behalf of the Respondent No.1 and of the Respondent No.2 not appeared either in person or by Advocate.

The Court made the following: ORDER

ORDER:

No representation on behalf of the petitioners.

2. Learned Assistant Public Prosecutor has submitted that subsequent to filing of the Criminal Petition, as there were no stay orders granted by this Court, the Police have completed investigation and filed charge sheet and to that extent he has filed copy of the letter addressed to Assistant Public Prosecutor signed by the Assistant Commissioner of Police, Pet Basheerabad, wherein it is stated that investigation is completed in Cr.No.166 of 2019 U/sec.417, 420 IPC and Sec.3(2)(va) of SC/ST (POA) Act of Alwal Police Station and also filed charge sheet, which is numbered as S.C.No. 6 of 2022 on the file of Sessions Court for trial of SC/ST (POA) Act cases - cum - VII Additional District and Sessions Judge, R.R. District at L.B. Nagar.

3. In view of the above submissions, since the very purpose of filing the Criminal Petition to quash the FIR in Crime No.166 of 2019 of Alwal Police Station registered under Sections 420 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, is defeated, the Criminal Petition has become infructuous.

4. Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is dismissed as infructuous. The petitioners are at liberty to challenge the charge sheet, if they so desire.

As a sequel, pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand closed.
