Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of the 2nd respondent vide his Proceedings No.P4/ 122(Auction 5)/2021-RR dated 04.03.2022 allotting the Stall No.53 in favour of the petitioner is highly unjust, arbitrary, illegal and unsustainable and consequentially direct the respondents to refund the EMD amount of the petitioner, relating to his tender in respect of Stall No.53 in MGBS, with interest at the rate of 18percent, declaring the action of the 2nd respondent in delaying the refund of the EMD amount is highly unjust, arbitrary, illegal and unsustainable and violative of Articles 14 and 21 of the Constitution of India.
