Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ of Mandamus or any other appropriate Writ, Order or direction, declaring the action of the respondent Nos. 3 and 4 herein, in not issuing Pattadar Pass Books and title deeds in favour of the petitioner herein, in respect of the land to an extent of 1200 Sq. Yards out of 2400 Sq.Yards approximately situated in between the Sy.No.12 of Upparapally and Sy.No.377 of Attapur Village Rajendranagar Mandal, Ranga Reddy District, as illegal, wholly arbitrary, and contrary to the Provisions of Revenue Laws and further direct the respondents herein, to issue pattadar pass books in favour of the petitioner herein, to an extent of 1200 Sq. yards of vacant land situated in between the Sy.No.12 of Upparapalli village and Sy.No.377 of Attapur Village Rajendranagar Mandal, Ranga Reddy District.

IA NO: 1 OF 2022

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents herein, not to interfere with the petitioner's peaceful possession and enjoyment of the land to an extent of 2400 Sq.yards situated in between the Sy.No.12 of Upparapally and Sy No.377 of Attapur Village Rajendranagar Mandal, Ranga Reddy District, pending disposal of the above Writ Petition.

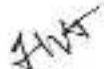
