Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus by declaring the action of the Respondents in not accepting the application for electricity connection to the petitioner building premises bearing Plot Nos.46/A and 47/A, each admeasuring 200 sq yards total admeasuring 400 sq yards in Sy.Nos.45 to 51, Situated at Maqtha Mahaboobpet Village, Serilingampally Mandal, Ranga Reddy District as illegal, arbitrary, unjust and consequently direct the respondents to receive the application for the electricity connections and release the power supply with twelve meters without any further delay.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the 3rd and 4th Respondents to receive the application and release power supply with twelve meters to the petitioner premises Bearing Plot Nos.46/A and 47/A, each admeasuring 200 sq yards total admeasuring 400 sq yards in Sy.Nos.45 to 51, Situated at Maqtha Mahaboobpet Village, Serilingampally Mandal, Ranga Reddy District.

The Court at the stage of admission made the following: ORDER

WRIT PETITION No.17737 of 2022

ORDER:

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned Government Pleader for Energy for respondent No.1 and Sri R.Vinod Reddy, learned Standing Counsel for Telangana State Southern Power Distribution Company Limited appearing for respondents 2 to 4. With their consent, the present Writ Petition is being disposed of at the stage of admission itself.

The main grievance of the petitioner is that the respondents are not providing electrical service connection to the subject premises situated at Maktha Mahaboobpet Village, Serilingampally Mandal, Ranga Reddy District.

The learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that though the petitioner has submitted an application along with necessary documents to the respondents for providing electricity service connection to the subject premises, the respondents are refusing to receive the same. The learned counsel has also stated that in similar circumstances, this Court has passed orders in W.P.No.26977 of 2021, dated 28.10.2021.

Sri R. Vinod Reddy, the learned Standing Counsel, on instructions, submits that if the petitioner files an application afresh, the same would be processed and necessary orders

would be passed and the same would be intimated to the petitioner.

Recording the aforesaid submission, this Writ Petition is disposed of with the direction to the petitioner to file an application afresh for providing electricity service connection to the subject property within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. On such application being filed, the respondents shall process the same and pass necessary orders thereon in accordance with the prescribed procedure and communicate the same to the petitioner, within a period of two weeks thereof. If the authorities have any objection for giving the power connection to the subject premises, the same shall be communicated to the petitioner.

The miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed. There shall be no order as to costs.
