ORDER:

This Criminal Petition is filed seeking quashment of FIR in Crime No.115 of 2019 dated 19.06.2019 of Police Station Town V - Nizambad, Nizambad District against the petitioner/Accused for the offence under Section 66 (A) of Information Technology Act, 2008.

02. Sri K.Pavan Kumar, learned counsel for the petitioner and Sri S.Ganesh, learned Assistant Public Prosecutor for respondent No.1/State as well as Sri N.Srushman Reddy, learned counsel for respondent No.2 are present.

Sri S.Ganesh, learned Assistant Public Prosecutor for the respondent No.1/State has submitted a copy of Letter dated 03.11.2022 addressed by Sub-Inspector of Police, Nizamabad V Town P.S., Nizambad District, wherein it is stated that the case has been referred as 'Action Dropped' on 08.07.2021.

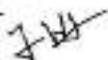
