CONTEMPT CASE No. 611 of 2022

ORDER:

1. This Contempt Case has been filed by the petitioner alleging non-compliance of the order dt.02.02.2022 in IA.No.1 of 2022 in W.P.No.4606 of 2022.
2. When the matter is taken up hearing, the learned Government Pleader for Services-I appearing for respondents has placed before this Court copy of Memo No.Spl/Secretary Peshi/2021 522, dt.07.07.2022, under the signature of the Secretary to Government, whereby it is stated that the appeal preferred by the petitioner was allowed and petitioner was found to be eligible for consideration in terms of G.O.Ms. No.317 GAD (SPF-I) Dept. dt. 06.12.2021, and Circular Memo No.1655/SPF.I/2021-7, dt.23.12.2021.
3. Learned Government Pleader further submits that though there has been some delay in implementing the above said order, the same is purely on account of administrative reasons and is neither willful nor wanton.

4. Having regard to the fact that the respondents, though with some delay, have complied with the above order passed by this Court, this Contempt Case is closed. Further, since the petitioner's case was found eligible for consideration, it is incumbent on the part of the District Collector and the District Educational Officer, concerned, to issue consequential proceedings, as expeditiously as possible. No order as to costs.

5. Consequently, miscellaneous petitions pending if any shall stand closed.
