ORDER:

This Criminal Petition is filed under Sections 437 and 439 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short "Cr.P.C") seeking regular bail to the petitioners who are arrayed as Accused Nos.1 to 3 in Crime No.1025 of 2021 on the file of Station House Officer, Shadnagar Police Station, Cyberabad registered for the offence punishable under Section 20(b)(ii)(B) of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that charge sheet is already filed.

3. Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is disposed off. However, the concerned Court shall entertain the bail application of these petitioners on the changed circumstances of charge sheet being filed and upon such application being filed; the same shall be disposed off by the concerned Court within two working days after giving opportunity of hearing the Public Prosecutor.
