Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of WRIT OF MANDAMUS declaring the action of the respondents in not awarding 5 marks as service weightage as per supplement notification issued by the respondents in supplemental Notification No.01/CGM(HR)2011,dated17-10-2011 to the petitioner is illegal, irregular, arbitrary and irrational and against the principles of natural justice as per articles 14 and 21 of constitution of India and consequently direct the respondents to award 5 marks as service weightage to the petitioner as per the clause stipulated in the notification;

ORDER:

The petitioner filed the present Writ Petition seeking a Writ of Mandamus to declare the action of the respondents in not awarding 5 marks as service weightage as per supplementary notification issued by the respondents in supplementary Notification No.01/CGM(HR)2011, dated 17.10.2011 to the petitioner as illegal, irregular, arbitrary, irrational and against the principles of natural justice and as per Articles 14 and 21 of Constitution of India and direct the respondents to award 5 marks as service weightage to the petitioner as per the said Notification.

2. On 30.03.2022, 12.07.2022, 01.08.2022, 02.08.2022 and there is no representation on behalf of the counsel for the petitioner on all the said dates. The matter is listed on 03.08.2022 under the caption "for dismissal". There is no representation on 03.08.2022 as well. On 04.08.2022 though the matter is called in the morning session and also in the afternoon session, after being passed over, there is however, no representation on behalf of the counsel for the petitioner. The counsel for the respondents is present.

3. Smt. A. Deepthi, learned counsel for the respondents draws the attention of this Court to Para No.18 of the counter affidavit filed by respondents 1 to 4 and contends that the total marks secured by the petitioner are 61.51 and even assuming without admitting by the relief prayed for by the petitioner is granted, yet the petitioner would not be qualified in view of the fact that cut off marks for non-local candidates are 78.79. The cut off marks for local candidates are 71.29 and the learned counsel for the respondents further seeks a direction for dismissal of the writ petition on the said ground.

4. Bringing the said fact on record that the petitioner secured less marks than the cut off marks, the writ petition is dismissed. There shall be no order as to costs.

5. Miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending in this writ petition, shall stand closed.
