ORDER:

This Criminal Petition is filed seeking quashment of Crime No.593 of 2020 dated 28.07.2020 of Narsingi Police Station, Cyderabad, registered against petitioner/Accused No.1 for the offence under Sections 420, 406, 506 of the Indian Penal Code and 156(3) of the Criminal Procedure Code.

02. No representation on behalf of the petitioner. Sri S.Ganesh, learned Assistant Public Prosecutor for respondent No.1/State as well as Sri M Bhoopathi, learned counsel for respondent No.2 are present.

03. Sri S.Ganesh, learned Assistant Public Prosecutor for respondent No.1/State has submitted that the police concerned have completed the investigation and charge sheet was also filed and numbered as C.C.No.2973 of 2021 and to that extent filed copy of proceedings of the E-Courts pertaining to this case of P.J.C.J-cum-AMM Courts, Rajendra Nagar.

04. In view of the facts and circumstances, since the investigation is completed and charge sheet is filed, the very purpose of filing the Criminal Petition to quash Crime No.593 of

2020 is deleted and thereby the Criminal Petition has become infructuous and liable to be dismissed.

05. Accordingly, this Criminal Petition is dismissed as infructuous.

As a sequel, pending Miscellaneous Applications, if any, shall stand closed.
