Petition Under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the respondents in issuing the alleged demand notice dated.03/02/2021 to the petitioners without following the Section. 202(1)(bb) GHMC Act and without considering the order judgment and decree in M.A. No. 86/2003 dated 7/11/2005 passed by the Honourable Chief Judge, City Small Causes Court at Hyderabad as illegal, arbitrary and contrary to G.O. MS No. 468 MA dated 31/07/1993 and Section.202 of the GHMC Act and set aside the same consequently by directing the respondents to re-fix / reassess the property tax considering Sec.202 of the GHMC Act and also taking into consideration of the nature of building at present.
