This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking pre-arrest bail to the petitioners, who are arrayed as Accused Nos.1 to 3 in the event of their arrest in Crime No.59 of 2018 on the file of Garidepalli Police Station, Suryapet District registered for the offences punishable under Sections 468, 471 and 420 of Indian Penal Code.

2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and learned Assistance Public Prosecutor for the respondent-State. Perused the record.

3. Since the punishment prescribed for the offences alleged against petitioners is upto seven years, without going into the merits of the matter, the respondent-Police are directed to carry out the investigation by following the procedure as contemplated under Section 41-A Cr.P.C and the guidelines formulated by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Arnesh Kumar v. State of Bihar*¹ scrupulously.
