Petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to quash the FIR No. 338 of 2014 dated 18-03-2014 under sections 420, 406, 506, 120(B) IPC and 156(3) of Cr.P.C. on the file of the Ps., Punjagutta, Hyderabad against the petitioners as the same is untenable either on facts or under law.
