1. This Contempt Case has been filed by the petitioner alleging non-compliance of the order dt.11.02.2022 in IA.No.1 of 2022 in W.P.No.7569 of 2022.

When the matter is taken up hearing, it is stated by the learned Government Pleader for Services-I appearing for respondents, that pursuant to the above said order, the respondents disposed of the appeal preferred by the petitioner vide Memo No.Spl/Secretary Peshi/2021-464, dt.13.05.2022.
