The Court made the following: ORDER

ORDER:

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. seeking pre-arrest bail to the petitioner/Accused, in the event of her arrest in connection with Crime No.180 of 2022 on the file of Ramachandrapuram Police Station, Cyberabad, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 417, 420, 468, 470, 471 of Indian Penal Code.

2. Learned Counsel for petitioner submits that the notice under Section 41-A of Cr.P.C. is already given, however, the police are harassing the petitioner by calling the petitioner to the police station, regularly.

3. Heard learned Assistant Public Prosecutor for the respondent-State.

4. Since the punishment prescribed for the offences alleged against the petitioner is up to seven years, without going into merits of the matter, respondent - Police are directed to scrupulously follow the procedure as contemplated under Section 41-A Cr.P.C and the guidelines formulated by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Arnesh Kumar v. State of Bihar**¹ scrupulously. It is needless to say, any deviation in this regard will be viewed seriously. Further, the concerned

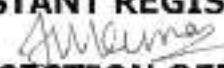

Investigating Officer is directed not to call the petitioner to the Police Station unless required for the purpose of investigation.
