Petition Under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ of Mandamus or any other appropriate Writ, order or direction, declaring the action of the respondents in not taking any action on petitioner representation dated 28.10.2015, acknowledged on the even date, in allowing the 7th respondent to run A4 liquor shop in the premises bearing No.13-4-595/1/2, Jiyaguda, Hyderabad under the name and style of Jai Darbar Maisamma Wines for the lease year 2015-17 commencing from 1st October, 2015 to 30th September,2017, though Ward No.62 was allotted two A4 licenses for running liquor shops, under the premise that premises bearing No.13-4-595/1/2 is situated in Ward No.61 of Karwan (the fact remains that the said premises is situated at 62, Jiyaguda) as illegal and arbitrary and for a consequential direction to the respondents 1 to 6 to take steps to shift the A4 licence shop run by the 7th respondent in the premises bearing No.13-4-595/1/2, Jiyaguda, Hyderabad to some other premises situated in Ward No. 61, Karwan, Hyderabad.
