Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ order or direction more particularly one in the nature of writ of mandamus, declaring the action of the respondents 2 and 3 in not issuing Fresh Pattadar Pass Book, Title Deed, Entry in E-Pahani and Entry in Dharani Portal in favour of the petitioner in respect of petitioners landed property covered by Sy.No.139/B admeasuring Ac. 6-14 guntas situated at Bandameedipalli H/o. Tattepalle Village, Peddemul Mandal, Vikarabad District by issuing fresh mutation proceedings and conducting survey by fixing boundaries with meets

and bounds in spite of receipt of the petitioners written representations as illegal, arbitrary, unjust and also against the provisions of Survey and Boundaries Act, 1923, against the provisions of T.S. ROR Act, 1971 and Rules, 1989 and also against Articles 14,19 and 300-A of the Constitution of India.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents to issue fresh Pattadar pass book, Title Deed, Entry in E-Pahani and Entry in Dharani Portal in favour of the petitioners in respect of petitioners landed property covered by Sy.No.139/B admeasuring Ac. 644 guntas situated at Bandameedipalli H/o, Tattapalle Village, Peddemul Mandal, Vikarabad District forthwith, pending disposal of the above writ petition.

ORDER:

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue appearing for the respondents. The writ petition is disposed of at the stage of admission.

2. The main grievance of the petitioners is that respondent Nos.2 and 3 are not considering the request of the petitioners for mutating their names in the revenue records and for issuance of digital pattadar passbooks and title deeds etc., in respect of land admeasuring Acs.6.14 guntas in Survey No.139/B situated at Bandameedipalli, H/o. Tattepalli Village, Peddemul Mandal, Vikarabad District.

3. Learned Government Pleader for Revenue submits that if the petitioners make applications through online in Dharani Portal, the same will be considered and necessary orders will be passed by the authorities concerned, in accordance with law.

4. Having regard to the above submissions, without going into the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of

directing the petitioners to make an application ventilating their grievance, through online Dharani Portal, within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. On such application being made, the authorities concerned shall pass necessary orders thereon strictly in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of eight weeks thereafter.

Miscellaneous Petitions, if any, pending in this writ petition shall stand closed.
