Petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to quash the FIR in Crime No.1 of 2016 and the Notice dated 06.04.2016 issued under Section 41 A (1) Cr.P.C in Crime No.01/2016 dtd. 06.01.2016 by the respondent directing the petitioners to appear on 25.04.2016 before the investigating officer, I town Police Station Nalgonda as illegal, unlawful and without jurisdiction.

Petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay of all further proceedings in FIR No.01/2016 dtd.06-04-2016, which was registered by the Police Station, Nalgonda I Town which is on the file of the Honorable Munsif Magistrate cum Judicial First class Magistrate, Nalgonda including the arrest of the petitioners pending disposal of the present Criminal Petition.

This Petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition and upon hearing the arguments of Sri VENKAT REDDY DONTI REDDY, Advocate for the Petitioner and the Assistant Public Prosecutor on behalf of the Respondent No.1

The Court made the following: ORDER

CRIMINAL PETITION No.5925 of 2016

ORDER:

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure by the petitioners to quash Crime No.1 of 2016 of Nalgonda I Town Police Station registered for the offences under Sections 370 (1)(2) & (3), 420 read with Section 120-B of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 18 and 19 of the A.P. Transplantation of Human Organ Act, 1995.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners has fairly submitted that subsequent to filing of the criminal petition, the Police concerned have completed entire investigation and filed charge sheet, which is numbered as PRC No.16 of 2021 and thus, the criminal petition has become infructuous.

3. Learned Assistant Public Prosecutor is present.

4. In view of the above submissions, since entire investigation is completed and charge sheet is also filed, the very purpose of filing the criminal petition to quash Crime No.1 of 2016 of Nalgonda I Town Police Station is defeated and thereby the criminal petition has become infructuous and liable to be dismissed.

5. Accordingly the criminal petition is dismissed as infructuous. However, the petitioners are given liberty to challenge the charge sheet, if they so desire:

As a sequel, the miscellaneous Petitions, pending if any, shall stand closed.
