Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue any writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of writ of mandamus declaring the action of the 1st Respondent in not issuing hall ticket, for the written examination of sought to be held on 24-05-2014 at Adilabad on the ground that one of my photographs is not attested as illegal, arbitrary and unjust and consequently direct the 1st respondent to issue hall ticket to the said examination in the interest of justice.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the 1st respondent to permit the petitioner to write the examination to the post of Junior Assistant scheduled to be held on 24-05-2014 at Adilabad by issuing hall ticket to petitioner, pending disposal of above writ petition.

WRIT PETITION No.14656 of 2014

ORDER: *(Per the Hon'ble the Chief Justice Satish Chandra Sharma)*

The petitioner before this Court has filed the present writ petition being aggrieved by the action of the respondents in not permitting the petitioner to appear in the written examination for the post of Junior Assistant.

The facts of the case reveal that the petitioner, pursuant to the notification dated 16.12.2013, applied for the post of Junior Assistant and he was required to affix three photographs duly attested by a Gazetted Officer. The photograph of the petitioner on the hall ticket was attested. However, it is stated that on account of oversight, the photograph was not attested by the Gazetted Officer on the application. Meaning thereby, only one photograph was not attested by the Gazetted Officer and this Court has permitted the petitioner to appear in the written examination in question.

Learned counsel for the High Court, on instructions, submits that the petitioner has cleared the examination

and is serving under the establishment of the District Judge, Adilabad.

It is nobody's case that the petitioner was not the person who has appeared in the examination and the authorities have verified the correctness of the photograph and merely because one photograph was not attested, this Court does not find any reason to cancel the appointment, which has already been done long back, especially when the same person whose photograph was on the hall ticket has appeared in the examination and obtained the job. At this juncture, no orders are required to be passed in the present writ petition.

The writ petition stands allowed accordingly.

The miscellaneous applications pending, if any, shall stand closed. There shall be no order as to costs.
