Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the inaction in disposing the representation dated 16/03/2022 by 2nd Respondent and Representation dated 11/02/2022 pending with 4th respondent submitted by the petitioner seeking rectification in survey numbers in respect of the subject lands as illegal, arbitrary, unjustified and consequently direct the Respondent No 2 and 3 to dispose of the pending representations of petitioner in the facts and circumstances of the case and in the interest of Justice and Equity

ORDER:

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue, for the respondents.

2. With the consent of both parties, the Writ Petition is disposed of at the stage of admission.

3. The grievance of petitioner in this Writ Petition is that though petitioner had purchased an extent of Acs.3.28 gts. in Survey No.482, situate at Yellareddygudem Village, Narketpally Mandal, Nalgonda District under a registered Document bearing No.5914/1998, dated 13.11.1998, from one Smt. K. Ramakka and the same was also mutated in the name of petitioner, Surprisingly the name of vendor of the petitioner viz., Smt. K. Ramakka is again reflected in the Dharani portal to an extent of Acs.0.25

gts. in Survey No.481 of the said village by showing Survey No.481 against the said extent of land.

4. According to learned counsel for the petitioner, the said Smt. K. Ramakka is not having any other land other than the land sold in favour of petitioner to an extent of Acs.3.28 gts.

5. Under those circumstances, petitioner claims to have submitted a representation dated 16.03.2022 to the 2nd respondent seeking rectification of the same. However, the said representation is still pending consideration before the 2nd respondent. Hence, petitioner seeks appropriate direction to direct the 2nd respondent to take immediate action on the said representation submitted by the petitioner.

6. Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue, for the respondents, submitted that the representation submitted by the petitioner herein dated 16.03.2022 may be directed to be considered by the respondents.

7. Taking into consideration the submissions on either side, the Writ Petition is disposed of directing 2nd respondent to consider the representation dated 16.03.2022 submitted by the petitioner and pass appropriate orders in accordance with law for rectifying the alleged erroneous entries made in the Revenue Records by duly putting the said Smt. K. Ramakka on notice within a period of two (02) months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

8. Accordingly, the Writ Petition is disposed of with the above direction. No order as to costs.

9. As a sequel, miscellaneous applications pending if any in this Writ Petition, shall stand closed.
