Petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay all further proceedings including arrest of petitioner in pursuance FIR No.218/2021 under section 290, 506 IPC and Section 3 [2] [va] of SC/ST [POA] Act 2015, Dated 27/09/2021 on the file of Parkal Town PS, Parkal Mandal, Warangal [Rural] District, pending disposal of the Criminal petition.

This Petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition and upon hearing the arguments of Sri SRINIVAS KUDUMULA, Advocate for the Petitioner and the Public Prosecutor on behalf of the Respondent No.1 and None Appeared for the Respondent No.2

The Court made the following: ORDER

THE HONOURABLE SRI JUSTICE K.SURENDER**CRIMINAL PETITION No.7668 OF 2021****ORDER:**

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr.P.C.') by the petitioner-Accused seeking to quash the proceedings against him in FIR No.218 of 2021 pending on the file of Station House Officer, Parkal Town Police Station, Warangal Rural District.

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner-Accused No.1 and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the respondent-State. Perused the material on record.

3. The petitioner-Accused is questioning the correctness of the registration of crime on the ground that a false complaint is made by the complainant. As seen from the complaint, the petitioner-Accused abused the complainant in the name of caste.

4. However, there are differences according to the petitioner-Accused between him and the complainant.

5. In the said circumstances, in the interest of justice, this Court deems it appropriate to direct the Investigating Officer in respect of FIR

No.218 of 2021 pending on the file of Station House Officer, Parkal Town Police Station, Warangal Rural District to conclude the investigation without arresting the petitioner-Accused and without taking any coercive steps against the petitioner. Further, the petitioner-Accused shall co-operate with the Investigating Officer as and when required for the purpose of investigation.

6. Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is disposed of.

Miscellaneous applications pending, if any, shall stand closed.
