Admn A1/016/2022 in suspending the petitioner as illegal, arbitrary and unconstitutional and consequently set aside the proceedings dt. 15/02/2022 issued by 3rd respondent and direct the respondent to continue the petitioner as in charge of MLS Point of Marikal Mandal, Narayanpet District, in the Civil Supplies Department.

ORDER

In this Writ Petition, the petitioner is challenging the proceedings dt.15.02.2022 whereby the petitioner has been suspended from service with immediate effect.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, Sri Rajagopallavan Tayi, submits that the petitioner has already submitted his explanation to the show-cause notice dt.03.03.2022, but the respondents have not taken any decision thereon and the petitioner is continued under suspension.

3. Learned Government Pleader for Services-III representing the respondents submits that since six months have lapsed after the date of suspension, the case of the petitioner will be reviewed under G.O.Ms.No.86 dt.08.03.1994.

4. Having regard to the above contentions and with the consent of both parties, this Writ Petition is disposed of directing the respondent No.3 to review the suspension order of the petitioner in terms of G.O.Ms.No.86 dt.08.03.1994 and take a decision thereon in accordance

with law within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

5. The Writ Petition is accordingly disposed of. No order as to costs.

6. Pending miscellaneous petitions, if any, in this Writ Petition shall stand closed.
