When the matter is taken up for hearing, it is noticed that, this Court has not suspended the operation of the Orders dated 09.12.2011 passed by the Andhra Pradesh Administrative Tribunal in O.A.No.1903 of 2011, which would mean that the Order of the Andhra Pradesh Administrative Tribunal has been worked out itself, thus rendering the present Writ Petition as infructuous.
