This Petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Palle Sriharinath, Advocate for the Petitioner and the Public Prosecutor (TG) on behalf of the Respondent No.1

The Court made the following: ORDER

CRIMINAL PETITION No. 6481 OF 2022

ORDER:

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. seeking pre-arrest bail to the petitioners, who are accused Nos.6, 7, 11 & 12 in the event of their arrest in connection with Crime No.263 of 2022 on the file of Nalgonda II Town Police Station, Nalgonda, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 420, 406 of Indian Penal Code.

2. Heard the learned Counsel for the petitioners and learned Assistant Public Prosecutor for the respondent-State.

3. Since the punishment prescribed for the offences alleged against the petitioners is up to seven years, without going into merits of the matter, respondent - Police are directed to scrupulously follow the procedure as contemplated under Section 41-A Cr.P.C and the guidelines formulated by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Arnesh Kumar v. State of Bihar**¹ scrupulously. It is needless to say, any deviation in this regard will be viewed seriously.

4. The Criminal Petition is accordingly, disposed off.

5. Miscellaneous applications pending, if any, in this criminal petition, shall stand closed.
