O R D E R:

This Criminal Revision Case is filed aggrieved by the Order passed in CrI.M.P.No.1642 of 2009 in DVC No.5 of 2009 dated 11.09.2009 on the file of learned XVII Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Hyderabad, which was filed under Section 23 of the Domestic Violence Act, 2005, wherein the petition is allowed.
