

THE HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE K.SURENDER

CRIMINAL PETITION No.6814 OF 2022

ORDER:

This Criminal Petitions is filed under Sections 437 and 439 of the Criminal Procedure Code by the petitioner/accused No.10 in Crime No.109/2022 on the file of LMD Colony Police Station, Karimnagar District, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 143, 120, 120(B) read with Section 149 of Indian Penal Code and Section 4 of the Explosive Substances Act, 1908 and Sections 10, 13, 16, 18 of the Unlawful Activities Prevention Amendment Act, 2008/2019.

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner/accused No.10 and learned Assistant Public Prosecutor for the respondent-State.

3. The case of the prosecution is that on 19.04.2022, Accused No.10 was arrested along with other accused. During the course of investigation, it was revealed that the petitioner, who is Accused No.10, was instrumental in supplying of certain quantity of explosives.

4. Learned Counsel for petitioner submits that apart from the confession of accused stating that the explosives were supplied by this petitioner, there is no other evidence connecting the petitioner to the crime. Therefore, prayed to grant bail to the petitioner/A10.

5. As seen from the remand report, the petitioner is arrayed as Accused No.10. However, for the reasons of there being no other

connecting evidence such as any seizures or any other evidence, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner/Accused No.10.

6. Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is allowed and the petitioners/A10 is granted bail subject to the following conditions:

- i) The petitioner/A10 shall execute personal bonds for a sum of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) each with two sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction of the Special Judicial Magistrate of First Class (Excise), at Karimnagar, Karimnagar District.
- ii) The petitioner/A10 shall appear before the concerned Station House Officer on every Sunday between 10.30 a.m. and 01.00 p.m. for a period of three (3) months or until filing of charge sheet, whichever is earlier.
- iii) The petitioner/A10 shall abide by the other conditions stipulated in Section 437(3) of Cr.P.C.

Miscellaneous applications, if any pending, shall stand closed.
