CRIMINAL REVISION CASE No. 1008 of 2011

ORDER:

This Criminal Revision Case is filed aggrieved by the Order passed in CrI.M.P.No.2256 of 2008 in C.C. No.74 of 2009 dated 06.04.2011 on the file of learned Special Judge for Economic Offences at Hyderabad, which was filed by the petitioner under Section 245 of the Criminal Code of Procedure, wherein the petition was dismissed.
