Petition under Section 438 of Cr.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners/Accused 1 and 2 and direct to Station House Officer, Dornakal (MBBD) Police Station, Mahabubabad District to release the petitioners/Accused No. 1 and 2 on bail in the event of petitioners arrest in crime No. 141 of 2022.

This Petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition and upon hearing the arguments of Sri B. Ramulu, Advocate for the Petitioner and the Assistant Public Prosecutor (TG) on behalf of the Respondent No.1 and none appeared for the Respondent No.2.

The Court made the following: ORDER

CRIMINAL PETITION NO.6888 OF 2022

ORDER:

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. seeking pre-arrest bail to the petitioners/Accused Nos.1 and 2, in the event of their arrest in connection with Crime No.141 of 2022 on the file of Dornakal (MBBD) Police Station, Mahabubabad District, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 420, 468 and 471 IPC.

2. Heard the learned Counsel for the petitioners and learned Assistant Public Prosecutor for the respondent-State.

3. Since the punishment prescribed for the offences alleged against the petitioners is up to seven years, without going into merits of the matter, respondent - Police are directed to scrupulously follow the procedure as contemplated under Section 41-A Cr.P.C and the guidelines formulated by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Arnesh Kumar v. State of Bihar**¹. It is needless to say, any deviation in this regard will be viewed seriously.

4. The Criminal Petition is accordingly, disposed of. Miscellaneous applications pending, if any, in this criminal petition, shall stand closed.
