Petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the Principal Sessions Judge Court, Medchal-Malkajgiri District at Malkajgiri to dispose of CrI.A.No.518/2019 expeditiously within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of the order in the interest of justice.

This Petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Anand, Advocate rep. Sri P.NAGENDRA REDDY, Advocate for the Petitioner and of the Public Prosecutor (TG) on behalf of the Respondent No.2 and None appeared for the Respondent No.1.

The Court made the following: ORDER

CRIMINAL PETITION No.6945 OF 2022ORDER:-

1. Heard the submission of Sri Anand who argued on behalf of Sri P.Nagendra Reddy, learned counsel on record for the petitioner. Also heard the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

2. Seeking the Court to direct the Court of Metropolitan Sessions Judge, Medchal, Malkajgiri District, to dispose of CrI.A.No 518 of 2019 that is pending on the file of the said Court expeditiously, the present Criminal Petition is filed.

3. Petitioner herein is the respondent No.2 to the said appeal. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the Criminal Appeal is of the year 2019 and the only request of the petitioner is to direct the Appellate Court to dispose of the said appeal time bound.

4. The relief sought for appears justifiable. Therefore, this Court considers desirable to allow the Criminal Petition.

5. Resultantly, the Criminal Petition is allowed. The Court of Metropolitan Sessions Judge, Medchal, Malkajgiri

District, is directed to dispose of the Criminal Appeal No.518 of 2019 that is pending on the file of the said Court, preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

6. As a sequel thereto, miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed.
