Station Korutla, Jagtial District, to release the Petitioner/Accused on Bail in the
event of his arrest in the interest of justice.

This Petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Memorandum of
Grounds of Criminal Petition and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Mohd
Saifuddin Ghor, Advocate for the Petitioner and the Assistant Public Prosecutor
on behalf of the Respondent.

The Court made the following: ORDER

THE HONOURABLE SRI JUSTICE K.SURENDER**CRIMINAL PETITION No.7082 OF 2022****ORDER:**

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking bail to the petitioner who is arrayed as Accused in the event of his arrest in Crime No.200 of 2022 on the file of Station House Officer, Korutla Police Station, Jagtial District, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 458 and 376 of Indian Penal Code.

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner/Accused and learned Assistant Public Prosecutor for the Respondent-State.

3. Learned Assistant Public Prosecutor submits that charge sheet is already filed in the present case and the petitioner is shown as absconding. He further submits that it is not known whether NBWs are pending against this petitioner.

4. In the said circumstances, when the charge sheet is filed, there cannot be any apprehension for this petitioner that he would be arrested. In the event of any NBWs being issued by the concerned Court, the petitioner can approach the said Court for

recalling the warrants issued under Section 70(2) of Cr.P.C., in the event of pending warrants.

5. Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is disposed off.

6. As a sequel thereto, miscellaneous applications, if any pending, shall stand closed.
