No. 6472 of 2019 U/s. 498A of IPC and Sections 3 and 4 of DP Act before III Metropolitan Magistrate at L. B. Nagar Ranga Reddy District and may pass such other order or orders

Petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay all further proceedings in C.C. No. 6472 of 2019 U/s. 498A of IPC and Sections 3 & 4 of DP Act before III Metropolitan Magistrate at L. B. Nagar Ranga Reddy District dispensing with the personal appearance of the petitioners pending disposal of the above Criminal Petition and pass such other order or orders

This Petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition and upon hearing the arguments of Sri AMRUTHA SANJEEVA, Advocate for the Petitioners and of the Additional Public Prosecutor (TG) on behalf of the Respondent No.1 and of no Advocate for the Respondent No.2.

The Court made the following: ORDER

CRIMINAL PETITION No.7050 of 2022

ORDER:

Seeking to quash the proceedings that are pending against the petitioners/Accused No.1 and 2 in C.C. No.6472 of 2019 on the file of the Court of III Metropolitan Magistrate at L.B. Nagar, Ranga Reddy District, the present Criminal Petition is filed.

2. Heard Sri Amrutha Sanjeev, learned counsel for the petitioners/Accused No.1 and 2, and as well as the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor, who is representing respondent No.1 - State. Having regard to the limited request made by learned counsel for the petitioners, issuance of notice to respondent No.2/defacto complainant is felt not necessary.

3. Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners have not committed any offence whatsoever and they never demanded any additional dowry as narrated in the charge-sheet, therefore, proceedings against them are not maintainable. Further, learned Counsel states that no further orders in this Criminal petition are required except to dispense with attendance of the 2nd petitioner before the trial Court on each and every date of adjournment as she is an aged woman. Learned Assistant

Public Prosecutor did not raise any serious objection for grant of such relief.

4. The Criminal Petition is therefore disposed of with the following directions:

(1) The Court of III Metropolitan Magistrate at L.B. Nagar, Ranga Reddy District is directed not to insist the personal appearance of petitioner No.2/Accused No.2 in C.C.No.6472 of 2019 that is pending before the said Court during the course of proceedings, in case she is represented by an Advocate.

(2) However, the petitioner/Accused No.2 shall make her appearance before the trial Court in case a specific direction to that effect is issued.

(3) It is made clear that such an exemption is not granted as far as petitioner No.1/Accused No.1 is concerned.

5. As a sequel, miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed.
