Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an order or direction, more in the nature of writ of mandamus, treating 1st respondent action vide order No.GP/MES/C/GPF No.162612 dated 22-3-2002 copy at page 20 as part payment due to improper calculation of interest, illegal deduction of Rs.3,768/- without prior notice and settlement, and omission in posting subscription Rs.50/- for 7/85 being contrary to the facts and provisions of law Rule 34, consequently 1st respondent's order dated 22-3-2002 has taken away or abridged the rights conferred under Article 14 Right to Equality or Equal protection of laws and the above order being in contravention of Article 13. (2) shall to the extent of contravention, be void, consequently direct him to recast the GPF account from the beginning to end and to pay me difference with interest upto the actual date of payment. b) To issue an interim order or interim direction to the 2nd and 3rd respondents, for passing necessary review order in

respect of (a) Rs.50/- omitted to mention after the word interest in line 11 in para 7 of page 6 of order dt.1-4-2004 (b) to incorporate the compliance period, i.e. The respondents are directed to comply with the order within month(s) from the date of receipt of this order. c) To issue an order or direction to produce the records resting with the GPF ledger account along with counter affidavit.
