COMMON JUDGMENT: (Per Hon'ble Dr.SA,J)

These appeals, under Section 37(1)(a) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, are filed by the appellants aggrieved by the common order, dated 29.08.2006, passed in I.A.Nos.2768 and 2769 of 2006 in O.P.No.1307 of 2006 by the learned II Additional Chief Judge, City Civil Court, Hyderabad.
