WRIT PETITION No.22157 of 2005

ORDER:

This writ petition is filed seeking the following relief;

" to issue a Writ, Order or direction, more particularly a Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of the 2nd respondent in not sending the Service Registers to the 3rd respondent, inspite of permission accorded by the 1st respondent in D.DIS No.A1/45705/2004,dated 12.10.2004 as arbitrary, illegal and violative of principles of natural justice and Articles 14,21 and 300A of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the 2nd respondent to send the Service Registers of the Petitioners to the 3rd Respondent for taking appropriate action regarding fixation of their Pensionary benefits."

2. The Executive Officer of the respondent No.2 filed the counter stating that they submitted service registers to the Audit Officer i.e., the respondent No.3 and the respondent No.3 in turn returned the service books along with the proceedings stating that they shall be paid as per the pension scheme, as contemplated in G.O.Ms.No.839, dated 03.12.1999 of the Government of Andhra Pradesh.

3. In view of the same, the grievance of the petitioners have already considered and redressed by the respondent

No.2 temple. Therefore, no further orders need be passed in this Writ Petition.

4. With the above observation, the Writ Petition is accordingly closed. No costs.

Consequently, miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed.
