CONTEMPT CASE No.1556 of 2022

ORDER:

The Contempt Case is filed alleging wilful and deliberate disobedience of the orders of this Court in W.P.No.7989 of 2021 dated 29.03.2022 by the respondents and to punish the respondents for the same.

2. The petitioner alleged that in spite of the directions of this Court, the respondents have not complied with the directions of this Court.

3. After issuance of notice, the respondents have appeared and the Assistant Pay and Accounts Officer has been made as respondent No.4 *suo moto* by this Court.

4. Learned Government Pleader for Services-I appearing for respondent No.4, today has filed the details of the amount paid to the petitioner by three cheques i.e., two cheques dated 03.11.2022 and a cheque dated 21.12.2022. It is submitted that the said amount has been deposited into bank account of the petitioner and stated that the petitioner has also withdrawn the same.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the prayer in the Writ Petition was for revision of pension as well and since, the writ petition is allowed, the respondents are yet to comply with the said part of the order.

6. However, this Court finds that in the last para of the order of this Court, the direction was only to make payment for suspension period within a period of 90 days from the date of receipt of the copy of the order. Since, the said amount has already been paid, this Court does not find that there is any wilful and deliberate disobedience on the part of the respondent in complying with the directions of this Court and any case for contempt. The petitioner is at liberty to pursue the remedy for revision of pension.

7. Accordingly, the Contempt Case is closed. There shall be no order as to costs.

Miscellaneous applications, if any pending, shall also stand closed.
