Ramachandrapuram Cyberabad District,.(Ranga Reddy district ) against the petitioners /Accused Nos-1 and 2.

Petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to Stay of all further proceedings including arrest of the Petitioners/Accused Nos.1 and 2 in Crime No. 473 of 2022 on the file of P.S. Ramachandrapuram Cyberabad District, (Ranga Reddy district ) pending disposal of the Criminal Petition.

This Petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition and upon hearing the arguments of Sri P. Padma Rao, Advocate for the Petitioner and the Additional Public Prosecutor on behalf of the Respondent No.1 and None Appeared for the Respondent No. 2

**The Court made the following: ORDER**

**THE HONOURABLE SRI JUSTICE K.SURENDER****CRIMINAL PETITION No.8596 OF 2022****ORDER:**

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr.P.C.') by the petitioners-Accused Nos.1 and 2 to quash the proceedings against them in FIR No.473 of 2022 pending on the file of Station House Officer, Ramachandrapuram Police Station, Cyberabad, registered for the offences under Sections 323, 504 and 506 of Indian Penal Code (for short "IPC").

2. Briefly the facts of the case are that, the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent – *de facto* complainant filed the present complaint against the petitioners herein alleging that 1<sup>st</sup> petitioner who is her younger daughter and 2<sup>nd</sup> petitioner who is her son-in-law (husband of 1<sup>st</sup> petitioner) have set an evil eye on her properties and with their gullible words got registered the properties in the name of 1<sup>st</sup> petitioner without giving any amount. On 01.06.2022 when the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent asked her daughter to return her properties, the petitioners beat her with hands, abused her in filthy language and threatened to kill her.

3. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners – Accused Nos.1 and 2 and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent – State.

4. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, predominantly there are disputes between the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent and the petitioners with regard to properties, for which reason, this Court deems it appropriate to direct the Investigating Officer in FIR No.473 of 2022 pending on the file of Station House Officer, Ramachandrapuram Police Station, Cyberabad to conclude the investigation without arresting the petitioners – Accused Nos.1 and 2.

5. Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is disposed off.

Miscellaneous applications pending, if any, shall stand closed.
